TEAM KUMITE RULES

- Single elimination, **NO REPECHAGE**.
- Winning team will be determined by total points combined of all matches.
- Disqualification of Individual Competitors in Team matches: HANSOKU or SHIKKAKU – in Team Matches, the offended competitor's score will be set at eight points/highest score and the offender's score will be zeroed.
- Match will continue for the full bout duration, point difference will not be applicable.

Participation Requirements

Please ensure your athletes, officials, and parents are aware of the following:

- **International athletes, officials, and coaches MUST** have their own insurance to participate in North Bay Open 2025 tournament (including USA).

REGISTRATION

- NO ON-SITE REGISTRATION.
- Dojo heads ONLY may request athlete information changes until July 14, 2025. After that, all draw brackets are final.
- Schedule and category brackets will be posted after July 14, 2025.
- Dojo Heads must register all club athletes under one account.
- All clubs and athletes must have 2025 Karate Ontario membership in good standing.
- Athletes registered under a different club than in the KO database will be disqualified (Team categories excluded).
- Elite division athletes may not compete in similar Recreational divisions.
- Officials and sportdata technicians must be registered through a KO-registered club in Sportdata to be eligible for payment. Payment is based on the posted event schedule.

COACH'S PASS

- Only registered coaches with a valid coach's pass may be on the tournament floor or sit in the chair.
- Coaches must be registered in SportData and meet NCCP requirements. Enter coaching level in the "Passport ID" field.
- Coaches must wear the official tracksuit and always display official ID during the event.

COACH / ATHLETE / PARENT INFORMATION

- Tournament begins at 7:55 AM sharp.
- Arrive at least 30 minutes before your division starts.
- Categories will be announced prior to each division.
- Elite kumite athletes may be required to weigh in before competing.
- No refunds for missed divisions.
- **Team divisions will be completed first (in the morning), with individual divisions to follow.**

- Elite 2 - August 17th, 2025 - Waterloo, ON N2K 4K4
- Elite 3 - September 28, 2025: 4899 Uplands Dr, Ottawa, ON K1V 2N6 - OPEN
- Elite 4 - October 19, 2025: SaveMax Sports Centre – 1495 Sandalwood Pkway East, Brampton, ON L6R 0K2
- Elite 5 - November 2025: Windsor – OPEN
- Elite 6 - January 11, 2026 – Markham Pan Am Centre – 16 Main St Unionville, Markham, ON L3R 0W7
- Elite 7 - March 1, 2026 – Haber Recreation Centre – 3040 Tim Dobbie Dr, Burlington, ON L7M 0M3

Team Ontario Points Criteria Nationals

The following are the points that will be awarded for Karate Ontario tournaments:

- **Gold:** 50 points
- **Silver:** 40 points
- **Bronze:** 25 points – 2 bronze medals are awarded.
- **Fifth & Sixth:** 12.5 points
- **Participation:** 1 point

Karate Ontario team training:

- Team training participation fees is \$300/athlete for the whole season – OPEN TO ALL ATHLETES.
- Team trainings began May 2025.

Youth League/ Worlds/ Pan ams Points

- If an athlete is unable to attend a provincial tournament due to participation in a Youth League, World Championships, or Pan American Games, the average of their points from all other events will be used to replace the missed provincial event. **This substitution will only apply if the international event occurs within one week before or after the scheduled provincial tournament.**

Team Ontario Fitness Test Requirement

To qualify for Team Ontario, athletes are required to successfully complete a fitness test. Baseline assessments and testing will be conducted during team trainings. Further details regarding the fitness test will be provided shortly.

Participation Requirements

All seven Karate Ontario tournaments held between July and March 2026 will serve as qualifiers. For selection purposes, the top three tournament point results will be counted for Senior athletes, and the top four for Junior athletes.

RULES

WKF rules will be followed for all divisions.

Age Eligibility

Athlete ages 10-15 years may not participate in different age groups or different weight category. 16 years and up may participate in multiple age-appropriate categories.

The Club Instructor/Coach is responsible for registering their athletes into appropriate age category.

Weight Eligibility

You may only compete in one weight class per age group. When registering, please take into consideration that some junior athletes are still growing.

Maximum Weight Allowance:

A weight allowance of 3kg over their preferred weight class, on the tournament day.

Minimum Weight Allowance:

- Athletes ages 10 - 17 can weigh in 3kg below the weight allowance.
- U21 & Senior athletes can weigh in 2kg below the weight allowance.

Kumite

- 6+ athletes: Full Double Elimination format. 5 or fewer: Round Robin format.
- Bout durations:
 - Men/Women: 3 min (stop time)
 - Juniors (14–17): 2 min (stop time)
 - Kids (10–13): 1.5 min (stop time)
- Mandatory WKF protective gear: <https://www.wkf.net/structure-statutes-rules>
- Headgear required for ages 10–13; WKF facemasks highly recommended. Tatami managers will enforce.
- Parents/coaches assume responsibility if facemask is not worn—Karate Ontario not liable for injuries.
- 14–17 categories: Groin protectors mandatory and Headgear optional (not used internationally by Karate Canada).

Kumite

- Category 1 Hansoku – Injury Disqualification
 - If an athlete causes a severe injury leading to a Category 1 Hansoku and the opponent cannot continue, they are disqualified from the division and lose double-elimination rights.
 - The referee panel must assess if the injury was due to Mubobi (selfendangerment) before final decision.
 - All cases must be reported to the tournament.
 - Repeat offenses may lead to suspension from future Karate Ontario events.

Kata

- Kata may not be repeated during the first 5 matches for adults and U21, first 4 matches for juniors.
- Kata divisions 6+ matches are quadrel round robin by scores, 5 or less round robin by flags.
- Only kata from official list may be performed.
- Competitors must know official WKF kata number:

Attire Guidelines

- Referees/Judges: Must wear appropriate official attire.
- Athletes: WKF-approved uniform, red/blue belts, and protective gear required.
- Coaches: Must wear the official tracksuit and display official ID

COACHES: It is your responsibility to ensure your athletes have proper uniform and equipment.
